

Module 1 – The Basics

In this **2 hour module**, you'll explore the following:

Activity #1 – The Queer Community (14 min) – p. 6

We'll start with An Introduction to the Queer Community, where you will be watching a video providing a basic breakdown of the LGBTQ acronym, the definitions and spectrums of sex assigned at birth, gender identity, gender expression, and sexual orientation, as well as terms to avoid. You'll then reflect or discuss the video using the questions provided.

Activity #2 – LGBTQ+ Glossary (21 min) – p. 10

Next, we'll be going through an LGBTQ glossary to dig a little deeper into some of the terms mentioned in the first video, as well as some terms you may or may not have heard before. You will be reading through definitions, as well as choosing linked videos to watch for terms you're interested in learning more about. You will then reflect or discuss the glossary using the questions provided

Activity #3 – Gender Unicorn (17 min) – p. 13

A fun activity where you will be reflecting on your own identity. You will use the question provided to reflect on the development of your identity as well as put a name to some of your identities.

Activity #4 – Intersectionality (25 min) – p. 18

You will be watching a video on Intersectionality. "Intersectionality" is a term that describes the intersections of identities that form unique experiences of oppression and violence that are important to understand in order to be a better coworker, a better teacher, and a better ally. And of course, you will debrief the video by reflecting on or discussing the questions provided.

Conclusion – Homework + Evaluation (17 min) – p. 22

To wrap it all up, consider completing one or more of the homework assignments to put what you learned into practice. Then, complete the evaluation form at the end. This will help you assess your learning as you go through the modules.
